## **Interalpen-Hotel Tyrol completes the redesign of its beauty and massage space**

**In May 2017 the Interalpen-Hotel Tyrol completed renovation of all treatment rooms in the Interalpen-Spa, which covers over 5,300 square metres. The space has been modernised from top to bottom and includes 14 different areas, including a special area for couple's massages, a Men's Spa, a Private Spa and an innovative Express Beauty area.**

The Beauty and Massage area of the IHT has been given its own special make-over during a several-week long closure. Under the direction of Zurich Architects Monoplan, the individual treatments and therapies area has been extended and fitted with state-of-the-art technical facilities. So for example lighting can be set to reflect the phase of the treatment, and music can be selected from several genres to suit the client's personal taste, or they can play their own favourites. Hotel guests can now enjoy a Men's Spa, treatment rooms for couple's massages and a Private Spa with a huge bathtub, a separate steam shower and its own sauna. And the new Express Beauty area offers manicures and personal styling consultations.

The hotel had already extended its Wellness facilities in May 2016 to include a 'textile' sauna area, to appeal to international guests and families. This completely new installation covers a generous 230 square metres and offers an infra-red salt-water cabin plus a bio sauna, a steam bath and a Finnish sauna for guests who prefer to keep their bathing costume on. In keeping with the pool area, the textile sauna area also makes attractive use of natural, regionally sourced design features. For example a wall in the Finnish sauna is decorated with natural rock, and there's a heated rock bed in the relaxation zone.

The Tyrolean Sauna Village was completely renovated half a year later and stylish mountain elements and granite grey are now a common theme throughout the entire Wellness area. The Sauna Village appears more spacious and the facilities have been enhanced, with additional, multi-sensory showers

and an arolla pinewood infra-red cabin. In the fourth and final renovation phase, the area around the Spa reception will be given a make-over.

The Interlpen-Hotel Tyrol's fabulous Wellness facilities are complemented by a 50-metre long indoor pool and a heated outdoor pool, set in a beautiful 10,000 square metre Spa Garden with views of the imposing Tyrolean Alps.

The Interlpen-Private Spa provides completely individual relaxation in a personal space with a wellness bathtub, where coffee, tea, soft drinks and fruit complete the offer. The whole Spa experience will be in full focus from 23 November to 1 December 2017 during the hotel's Wellness Autumn event. Special treatment offers, extended opening times in the panorama pool and swimming by candlelight are just some of the Spa highlights. A programme including a glamorous Casino Night in the Hofburg or a traditional Tyrolean wine-tasting in the Interlpen-Mountain Hut make this the place to be for Spa enthusiasts in the last week in November.
