Guests who prefer to explore by car rather than on foot are ideally placed for day trips to nearby Innsbruck, Munich, Bolzano in Italy or even into Switzerland. Three countries can be reached comfortably on day trips From this central location, with the Interalpen-Road Book as your perfect guide.

A holiday at the Interalpen-Hotel Tyrol means that you don't have to restrict your excursions to Austria. Enjoying a unique location in the middle of pristine nature, and yet within easy reach of the Innsbruck – Munich motorway system, the hotel is an ideal starting point for scenic day trips around the Tyrol and to neighbouring countries.

If retail therapy is your desire, you are just 40 km away from Innsbruck, where exceptional boutiques and designer clothing can be found in the historic buildings of the old town quarter. This city, whose most iconic view is the Golden Roof with the imposing Karwendel Mountains beyond, offers incomparable Alpine urban style.

The Bavarian capital of Munich boasts a wealth of cultural attractions, and is just a two hour drive from the hotel. Numerous galleries, museums, theatres and the world famous Bavarian State Opera are just some of the reasons to visit. Of course, a refreshing break in a shady Munich beer garden should not be missed.

For a taste of southern flair during your Austrian holiday, the Italian border is within easy reach, with the Brenner Pass just under an hour away. Indeed, the picturesque little city of Bolzano, just 50 kilometres from the hotel, on the southern side of the Alps, already has an Italian feel. The climate is milder

and more Mediterranean, the landscape gentler and vineyard-covered slopes give more than a hint of Italy.

And you can even pop to Switzerland for the day: the drive from Telfs to St. Gallen is just over two hours. This beautiful town between Lake Constance and the peak of Säntis will be hosting the 12th St. Gallen Festival from 23 June to 7 July, set in a monastery courtyard against a backdrop of the magnificent baroque cathedral, which is a UNESCO world cultural heritage site.

The InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol team has put together in an InterAlpen-Road Book for its guests, which gives full details of the most scenic excursions in the region. The highlight of the collection is the Three Country Tour starting in Austria, with a refreshment stop in the Swiss Alpine village of Samnaun, and a detour across the Reschen Pass to Lago di Rèsia, an artificial lake in South Tyrol, Italy. This scenic tour covers 260 kilometres and you can be back comfortably by evening to enjoy your dinner at the InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol.
