Countdown at the InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol

Opening of the new Penthouse Suites on 1st August 2019

After four months of reconstruction, guests at the InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol will be able to enjoy the luxurious atmosphere of seven new Penthouse Suites from 1st August 2019. Every room of these generously-dimensioned top-floor living spaces provides an unrestricted sweeping view of the surrounding alpine panorama, as hotel guests savour a whole new standard of exclusivity and privacy.

“From 1st August we will be receiving our first guests in the brand-new Penthouse Suites on the 7th floor of the hotel”, announced Karl Brüggemann, director of the InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol in the Seefeld region. The opening of the new suites marks the end of one of the most spectacular reconstruction projects ever undertaken by this 5-star superior hotel. The Panorama Suite *Superior* – offers 76 square metres of living space. Each of the four Penthouse Suites *Deluxe* guarantees 117 square metres of freedom, and each of the two Grand Suites occupies over 200 square metres of floor space. As the hotel director explains: “The 7th floor is exactly 1,375 metres above sea level and boasts 882 square metres of patio. Furthermore, around 300 square metres of windows have

been installed to thrill guests with completely unobstructed views of the stunning mountain scenery." Alongside the spacious patios and breathtaking views, each of the suites offers a lounge, a lifestyle shower, a free-standing bathtub and interiors in pleasant natural colours. Using frameless top-to-bottom windows, the Swiss architects from Monoplan have almost obscured the lines between indoors and outdoors, combining nature and interior living space to form one great, harmonious whole.

The 5-star superior hotel is now able to offer guests a whole new standard of exclusivity in its two Penthouse Suites *Grand*. The sophisticated master living room has been fitted with a tastefully-designed dining space for up to eight people. There are separate cooking facilities and the dining area merges with the living room area, which is furnished with a variety of natural materials and allows occupants to gather the leather seats around the fireplace. A panorama niche at the window facilitates wonderful sweeping views, however frosty the weather outside. Absolute privacy is assured in the private saunas in both of the 200 square metre suites. The oval outdoor tubs on the patios promise even more luxury. Without doubt, in future, soaking up the surrounding alpine magnificence or floating under a starlit sky will be spoken of as true highlights of a great stay at the InterAlpen-Hotel Tyrol.

The hotel looks forward to welcoming guests again, from the 19th June 2019, once all alteration work has been completed. The new Penthouse Suites can be booked from 1st August 2019.
